Fall Boating

Don't shrink-wrap or winterize that boat yet!

Autumn is one of the best times to boat.

With clear blue skies, beautiful puffs of white clouds and cool temperatures,

what's not to like?

After Labor Day many boaters put their boats away because they become too busy getting their children ready for school or feel it will be getting too cold to be out on the water.

But this is the time to get out on the water. Your favorite anchorage is probably less crowded or empty. Marinas, town docks and restaurants will have an open slip for you to dock at. For the trailer boaters the ramp will be quite with plenty of parking (unless you get there when a fishing tournament is launching their many boats).

Fishing can be very productive this time of year as the fish stuff themselves in preparation of a long cold winter.

Autumn also offers many beautiful sites. The birds are migrating and you may notice ones that are only seen this time of year. Mother nature is busy painting her house with many brilliant colors. There is a magic of leaf peeping from the water as all the colors are reflected in the still waters and then start to dance on your wake.

As the water-cools it is very important to wear your PFD. Hypothermia can set in quickly and trying to put a life jacket on after you are in the cold water will be nearly impossible.

So put on a jacket and a PFD and I will see you out on the water.
